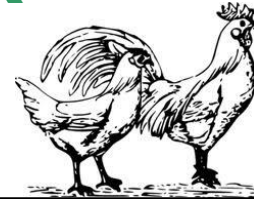

1. Competition is open to Bantams, large fowl and waterfowl.
2. Show is open to all youth who are 18 years old or younger. Must be 4-H or FFA member.
3. Classes will be: Bantam, Large Fowl, Waterfowl and each group will be broken down to: Cock, Hen, Cockerel and Pullet.
4. No one is allowed in the aisles during judging except the clerk, judge or show official.
5. No entry fee is needed.
6. No sick birds will be allowed.
- 7. Youth are limited to 10 poultry entries total.**
8. Handle your own birds unless permission is given by the owner.
9. APA and ABA standards will govern the classes.
10. Please do not coop out until judging is complete.
11. Pre-entry is required visit <http://mercerfairky.fairentry.com/> No entries day of event on Saturday.
12. All birds MUST be Pullorum Typhoid tested. Please bring current certificate if your birds have been tested. Any birds that haven't been tested will be tested on site by the Kentucky Department of Agriculture.
