ENTRY APPLICATION DEADLINE: July 4th**

PHOTO SESSION: All contestant photos must be taken by Morgan Lee Photography at one of the following dates:

June 9th 6-8pm or June 14th or June 16th between 5-8PM

Pictures held in the Stable Building at the Fairgrounds.

There will be NO extended dates for pictures.

Please do not contact the Harrodsburg Herald or Morgan for an extension.

**If photos are not taken within the allotted time frame you may still participate in the pageant, however you will not be in the program, newspaper, nor eligible for Most Photogenic.

Please make sure to complete/sign the publication permission form attached to application.

APPLICATION FEE:

The application fee is \$100.00... Checks must be made payable to Mercer County Fair & Horse Show.

RULES & DETAILS:

All applicants MUST be residents of Mercer County. (proof- verification required)

Contestants must be 13 years of age by Oct 31 & cannot turn 16 by Oct 31.

The winner will be representing the Mercer County Fair & Horse Show. At all times she should carry herself as a positive role model for the younger generation. The winner should refrain from smoking, drinking, using profanities, or excessive

Public displays of affection, Etc. while representing Teen Miss Mercer County in her crown and sash at any event.

The pageant director(s) and fair board reserve the right to revoke the crown and the awards if the winner is charged with felony, misdemeanor or, any negative social media activity. There will be a zero tolerance for any negative posting on social media sites by contestants or their families in regards to another contestant, the directors, or outcomes of the pageant. Such negativity could result in revoking the title as well as eligibility to ever compete again in the Mercer County Fair System.

Practice will be held in center ring. **dates & time subject to change.

Decisions of the judges are final...score sheets WILL NOT be given out after pageant, however judges are encouraged to make comments on the bottom of score sheets & those will be given out afterwards.

1. Will you accept my application in person? Yes, you can drop off your application at Succulent and Sassy on Mon, Tues, or Thurs. Place your application & entry fee in an envelope. On the outside of the envelope put attention to Sky Maddox Mrs. Mercer Director.
2. Will you accept late entries? No, the deadline has been Finalized.
3. Can we submit our own photograph? Sorry but we are not accepting ANY privately submitted photographs.
4. Will there be a meeting prior to practice? We are unsure at this time but will be contacting you once applications have been received.
5. How will the directors communicate with the contestants? Primary form of communication will be via text message. For this it is imperative that you provide us with any cell numbers that you want to receive communication concerning the pageant.
